

## EMERGENCY RIDE HOME PROGRAM

RTA offers a program that provides six rides home annually to registered, regular commuters in case of an emergency. To register for the Emergency Ride Home program, go to [musiccitystar.org](http://musiccitystar.org) or call Customer Care at 615-862-5950.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Packages and luggage are subject to search at any time.
- Unauthorized weapons are not allowed on the train or at the stations at any time.
- Electronic cigarettes, smoking, and use of tobacco products are prohibited.
- Use of seats as footstools is prohibited. Personal belongings must be kept out of aisles and off seats. Carry-on items must be stored under seats or on the luggage racks.
- Service animals are allowed on board.
- Disruptive or threatening behavior should be reported immediately to the conductor.
- Unattended bags or luggage are not allowed on the train or at the stations.

## SPECIAL NEEDS

All trains and stations are fully accessible for people with disabilities. For boarding assistance, please wait on the ramp. If you are hearing impaired, tell the conductor where you want to exit.

## BICYCLES

Bicycles may be stored in the wheelchair sections of each car, provided the areas are not being used. Passengers must supply their own tie-down cords to secure them.

## HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

The Music City Star operates weekdays, regardless of weather conditions. The train does not operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, and Christmas.

- **Monthly Pass** – unlimited travel between Riverfront Station and the station indicated on your ticket.
- **10-Ride Ticket** – 10 one-way rides
- **1-Ride Ticket (regular and reduced fare)** – 1 one-way ride

## GETTING STARTED

The Music City Star is the most convenient way for residents along the East Corridor to travel to and from downtown Nashville. Trains operate every weekday in the mornings and afternoons. The Music City Star will quickly and easily get you to Riverfront Station where connecting buses will be waiting to make sure you reach your final destination on time and stress-free. Welcome aboard!

## MUSIC CITY STAR STATIONS

The rail stations and their addresses are listed below. Each station, except for Riverfront, has a Park & Ride facility for Music City Star passengers to use free of charge.

- **Lebanon Station** – 334 W. Baddour Parkway, Lebanon
- **Hamilton Springs** - 1000 Gaston Park Drive, Lebanon
- **Martha Station** – 65 Martha Circle, Lebanon
- **Mt. Juliet Station** – 22 E. Division Street, Mt. Juliet
- **Hermitage Station** – 4121 Andrew Jackson Parkway, Hermitage
- **Donelson Station** – 2705 Lebanon Pike, Nashville
- **Riverfront Station** – 108 First Avenue S., Nashville

## HOW TO RIDE

- Purchase your 1-Ride Ticket, 10-Ride Ticket or Monthly Pass before boarding the train.
- Stand behind the yellow and blue safety lines on the platform to wait for the train.
- Give your ticket to the conductor to be validated.
- Once on board, listen for your stop announcement before the train approaches each station.

## PURCHASING TICKETS

Ticket vending Machines (TVMs) are located on the platforms at all train stations. TVMs sell only 1-Ride tickets at \$5.25 each, except Donelson (\$2.00 each). TVM's accept Visa, MasterCard, and Discover Cards only.

1-Ride tickets may be purchased onboard, cash only, from the conductor.

Advance Purchase 1-Ride Tickets (regular and reduced fare), 10-Ride Tickets and Monthly Passes are available inside Riverfront Station.

## CONNECTING BUS SERVICE

To help you complete your trip, WeGo Public Transit buses meet each train upon arrival at Riverfront Station.

Customers needing to travel to Vanderbilt or Belmont universities should board the **Route 93 Music City Star West End Shuttle**. Buses for this route depart from Bays 1 and 2 at Riverfront Station and travel along Broadway and West End to the Vanderbilt and Belmont campuses. (There is no additional cost for Music City Star riders to take a Route 93 bus.)

Customers needing to travel Downtown for work or to catch another bus should board the free **Music City Blue Circuit**. Buses for the Blue Circuit have scheduled stops at Riverfront Station each weekday to coincide with the train arrivals. Buses on the **Blue Circuit** depart from Bays 3 and 4 at Riverfront Station and travel north/south to Tennessee State University.

Music City Star customers also have the option of boarding other buses at Riverfront Station to reach their destinations. **Routes 6 Lebanon Pike, 25 Midtown, 36X Madison Express, and 44 MTA Shuttle** stop at Riverfront Station.

For the convenience of customers, WeGo Public Transit buses also meet the Music City Star at outlying stations. **Route 6 Lebanon Pike** serves Donelson Station. **Routes 6 and 27 Old Hickory** serve Hermitage Station.
